Rotary Exchange Program

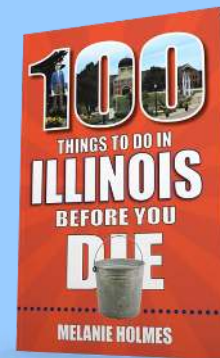

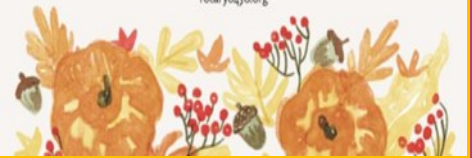

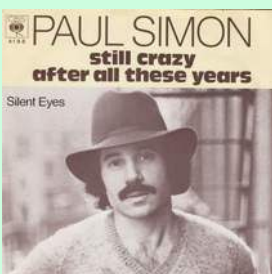
