This park offers a variety of recreational opportunities for all ages including paved trails, open recreational fields, playground equipment, shelters, picnic areas, farm animals, Indian caves, fruit tree orchards and memorial rose and flower gardens. It is part of the original Thomas Durham Homestead. Durham (1784-1854), a Quaker from Virginia, was the first non-Native American settler of the property.
